

WAX MOTH TRAP

Quantity	Materials & Ingredients
1	2-Litre Plastic Bottle (Smooth Sides Preferred)
	Baling Twine (For Hanging)
1 Cup	Sugar
1 Cup	Hot Water
1	Banana Peel
1 Cup	White Vinegar
	Water

Take a 2-litre plastic bottle with smooth sides (grooves in the bottle are like a ladder for insects to escape) and drill/cut a 1-inch hole just below the slope on the neck.

Add 1 cup of sugar, 1 cup of hot water, and 1 banana peel to a 2-litre plastic bottle and mix until sugar dissolves. Add 1 cup of white vinegar and then add water until the level in the 2-litre plastic bottle is about 50% to 75% of the volume of the bottle. Screw cap on 2-litre bottle and stir mixture; do not forget about 1-inch hole on the side of the bottle (use your hand, tape or a plastic shopping bag as a plug during the mixing step). Tie baling twine around the bottle neck and hang near hives. The wax moths will be attracted to the fermentation smell; enter in the 1-inch hole and drown in the liquid. This trap will also attract yellow jackets and hornets too. Rebatch once a month or as needed.
